

## MINIATURE QUILTS (example) 15" X 15"



Making a miniature quilt is very gratifying as you can usually cut, piece, quilt and bind a quilt in a day's time. This process allows one to experiment with colors and fabrics and become a more accomplished quilter. It is a nice break from working on a larger quilt.

### YARDAGE:

- 1      fatt quarter    light (for churn dash)
- 1      fatt quarter    dark (for churn dash)
- 1      fatt quarter    light (for setting blocks)
- 1      fatt quarter    dark (for setting blocks)
- ¼    yard for border and binding
- 1      fatt quarter    backing

- sewing machine in good working order
- single-hole throat plate
- 70/10 needle
- 50 wt neutral thread (Auriphil recommended)
- ¼ foot
- stiletto
- rotary cutter with new blade
- rotary mat
- 6" x 12" ruler
- 2½" sq ruler
- seam ripper
