

STAINED GLASS



This type of wall hanging is a very striking piece of art. The students will enjoy the finished quilt in their home or as an appreciated gift. There is now a process where one cuts the pieces, places the pre-glued leading (black bias) on block and sews the backing, batt, and wall hanging at the same time. (YOU MAY SUPPLY OWN PATTERN WITH CORRECT YARDAGE)

YARDAGE: (if you choose design above)
borders (4 colors each: 1/8 yd
background 1/2 yd
rose 1/4 yd
green 1/8 yd
white cotton material 2/3 yd (foundation piece)
black cotton backing fabric (2/3 yd)
batting cotton 24" x 22"

SUPPLIES:

sewing machine in good working order
thread (black – 50 wt) (recommend Aurifil)
rotary cutter with new blade
rotary cutting mat
6" x 12" ruler
15" sq ruler
BSS (basic sewing supplies) fabric and paper scissors
waxed paper
Teflon (appliqué pressing sheet)
Steam a Seam 2 (lite) (package)
fusible black Bias tape (10 yds by 1/4" wide)
fine tip black marker
double needle for sewing machine
Elmer school glue stick (washable)
slot-hole throat plate on machine

Necessary: flannel back tablecloth or flannel back vinyl for design wall
