

VERTICAL QUILTS (Miniature example shown)



These quick quilts feature a stripe of fabric the length of the project between other strips that have been pieced or appliquéd. This vertical quilt design is terrific for using your favorite 6" blocks made of scraps, two-color, or whatever compliments the (border) fabric. This full day class is for students with rotary cutting and piecing experience. Border prints will be the most desired fabric for this process.

YARDAGE:

4 $\frac{3}{4}$ yds border print (must cut to 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " widths, 5 strips)
2 yds setting triangles
1 yd light to compliment border print
1 yd dark to compliment border print
 $\frac{3}{4}$ yd for center stars
Plus, binding and backing yardage

SUPPIES: text optional: Vertical Quilts with Style, Aug and Newman

Sewing machine in good working order
Thread (neutral color, extra bobbins filled) 50 wt (recommend Aurifil)
Rotary cutter with new blade
Rotary cutter mat
6" x 24" ruler
6" x 12" ruler
6 or 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " ruler
BSS (basic sewing supplies) pins, scissors, pins, etc
Stiletto
Necessary: small flannel back tablecloth, or flannel back vinyl for design wall
