

WONDERFUL 1 FABRIC QUILTS (example)



This is a very new process to make a queen quilt top using but one fabric. Students will be delighted designing fun quilts with a few magic cuts and arrangements. This top is made with one fabric which eliminates the frustration of matching a number of fabrics. A great quilt to have fun piecing and learn about design.

YARDAGE: Queen size 6 – 8 yds border print (wallpaper print) with high contrast

in defined strips of design

Lap size 4- 5 yds

SUPPLIES: resource, Wonderful 1 Fabric Quilts, by Kay Nickols

Sewing machine in good working order, new needle

Rotary cutter

Rotary cutting mat

Rulers (6" or 8 ½" by 24")

6" by 12"

15" square or larger

Neutral color thread (light gray or beige) 50 wt. (Auriphil

Recommended)

Seam ripper

BSS (basic sewing supplies)

Necessary: flannel back small plastic tablecloth or flannel back vinyl for design wall
